

How to Use Your Yellow-lidded Recycling Bin Correctly

Do The Right Thing!

ONLY the following items are accepted in your yellow lid recycling bin:



Glass Bottles & Jars
Rinse, without lid



Milk & Juice Cartons



Cardboard Boxes



Newspaper, Paper & Magazines



Plastic Bottles & Containers
Rinse, without lid



Cans & Aerosols



Please rinse bottles & containers before disposing.

When you place **NOT ACCEPTED** items in your yellow lid recycling bin it causes “contamination”. High levels of contamination means materials cannot be recycled and have to be sent to landfill.

Stop Bin Contamination!

DO NOT place the following items in your yellow lid recycling bin:





Bin Audits: The Mandurah Recycling Education Officer uses the below stickers when auditing household recycling bins in the Mandurah area. The Recycling bin is checked for Non-Recyclable items and the appropriate sticker is placed on the lid of the Recycling Bin.

- Green Sticker: The Correct recyclable items have been placed in the recycling bin.
- White Sticker: Plastic bags have been placed in the recycling bin.
- Pink Sticker: Non-Recyclable items have been placed in the recycling bin.
